Antoine Quero is a financial advisor with the European Fund for Sustainable Development Plus (EFSD+) at the Directorate-General for International Partnerships (DG INTPA) of the European Commission since 2021.

After several years in the private sector, Antoine Quero joined the European Commission in 1995 where he has occupied several positions in the policy areas of R&D, budget, economic affairs and external relations.

In 2000, he designed the overhaul of the financial management at the European Commission. In 2007-09, he participated regularly to the Eurogroup, Ecofin and G-20 meetings in response to the Great Financial Crisis as Deputy Head of Cabinet and then Head of Cabinet of the Commissioner for Economic and Monetary Affairs. In 2014, Antoine Quero played an active role in the set-up of the European Fund for Strategic Investments (EFSI) or 'Juncker Plan'. Since then, he has been closely involved in the launch of EU investment programmes such as InvestEU or EFSD+.
