

Biography

Henrik Bliddal has been Deputy Secretary General of the NATO Parliamentary Assembly (NATO PA) since January 2020. His key priorities are mobilising support for Ukraine, championing democratic values, nurturing strategic partnerships and organisational transformation. He joined the NATO PA as the Director of the Science and Technology Committee in February 2011. Between October 2013 and 2020, he was also the Director of the Research Assistant Programme at the Assembly.

Mr Bliddal is the author of the monograph *Reforming Military Command Arrangements: The Case of the Rapid Deployment Joint Task Force* (Strategic Studies Institute, US Army War College, 2011) and co-editor of the book *Classics of International Relations: Essays in Criticism and Appreciation* (Routledge, 2013, with Casper Sylvest and Peter Wilson).

Since 2020, he has been a mentor for the Women in International Security (WIIS) Brussels programme.

He graduated with an MSc in Political Science from the University of Copenhagen, Denmark, in January 2010. He also studied at Dartmouth College (United States).

Mr Bliddal holds Danish and German citizenships.
