Project overview

Flow Equity Africa Ventures is part of the Hatch Africa group, which runs integrated poultry operations in six African countries. The group operates its own breeding facilities and hatcheries and produces dual-purpose day-old-chicks. It runs a last-mile distribution structure specifically aiming to enhance protein availability to smallholder households in rural areas.

Funding objective

EDFI AgriFI will provide an unsecured subordinated loan of USD 2 million to finance the construction of breeder farms and a hatchery, as well as acquire parent stock in Ghana. This will allow the group to secure production growth in the country and achieve profitability.

Investment rationale

FEAV's business model is impactful due to its innovative agent model stimulating entrepreneurship and creating jobs. Additionally, it introduces a hardy and productive breed of chicken to the African market, facilitating protein access to rural households, as well providing income-generating potential for these households.
